## Make the Biggest Number

Objective: To use understanding of place value to create the biggest number. To practice ordering numbers from least to greatest and write them in expanded notation.

Materials: Deck of cards 0-9 (use jacks as 0), game board
Directions: Players take turns drawing a card and recording the number in one of the available place values on their game board. Once a number has been recorded, it cannot be moved. At the end of the round (when all the spaces in the row have been filled), the player that has the highest number draws a star next to their number. The player with the most stars at the end of all five rounds is the winner.
**Variation of this game is to make the smallest number. For a challenge players can make numbers up to the one millions place.
